PART I | BEARING WITNESS IN POLAND

TUESDAY | APRIL 22, 2025 | The Kazmierz Legacy

- Our recommended flight arrives to Krakow in the late morning Travelers arriving on the designated flight and other flights arriving in the same timeframe will be accommodated with a complimentary airport transfer
- Check-in to our hotel in central Krakow meet our staff team and get oriented to the journey
- Introductory walking tour to Kazmierz Krakow's historic Jewish Quarter, where we honor the proud legacy of Polish Jewry dating back to the 14th Century – including stops at the Remu Synagogue, the Tempel Synagogue, old Jewish cemetery, and Jozefa Street
- Evening: **Welcome dinner at the Krakow JCC**, the center of a modern Jewish revival, where we will meet with the Executive Director, Jonathan Ornstein

WEDNESDAY | APRIL 23, 2025 | Confronting Auschwitz & Birkenau

- Arrive at the grounds of **Auschwitz II-Birkenau** where the full horror of the extermination of 1.5 million Jewish People is palpable (packed lunch provided)
- Continue to **Auschwitz I**, where we will tour the watchtowers, fences, cell blocks, wall of death, crematoria, and **Arbeit Macht Frei Gate**
- Close out the day visiting the **surviving synagogue of Oswiecim**, located just minutes from Auschwitz-Birkenau, to honor what was lost and to process the experience together
- Return to Krakow for dinner followed by a group night out at Old Town Market Square the biggest Medieval plaza in Europe

THURSDAY | APRIL 24, 2025 | Yom HaShoah – Holocaust Memorial Day

- Trace the history of the Holocaust at the **Krakow Ghetto**, the **Plaszow Labor Camp** and view the **Oscar Schindler Factory** from outside
- Return to Auschwitz where we join thousands of travelers from around the world in unity for the **March of the Living** (lunch is provided en route)
- Take part in the official **Yom HaShoah ceremony at Birkenau** attended by political leaders and dignitaries from Poland, Israel, and beyond
- Depart the Krakow region and travel through Poland's Galicia countryside to Lublin
- Pack an overnight bag for check-in to our Lublin hotel, where a catered dinner is served

FRIDAY | APRIL 25, 2025 | Lublin & Majdanek

- Morning walking tour of Lublin, including a visit to the **Chachmei Lublin Yeshiva**, a famed center of Jewish learning and the site of a massive Nazi book burning
- Arrive to the **Majdanek concentration camp**, originally set up for prisoners of war but soon turned into an infamous death camp for Jews and Poles (lunch is provided en route)
- Continue on to Warsaw, check in to our accommodations, and prepare for Shabbat
- Evening: Option to take part in a communal **Kabbalat Shabbat service** at the historic Nozyk Shul (orthodox) or Beit Warszawa (egalitarian)
- Reconvene for a catered Shabbat dinner experience at our hotel

SATURDAY | APRIL 26, 2025 | Warsaw Ghetto Uprising

ALL TOURING DURING THE DAY IS ON FOOT

- Free morning or Shabbat service options followed by a group Shabbat lunch
- Uprising! Explore the remains of the **Warsaw Ghetto** and learn about the Jewish community's famous revolt along the **Route of Heroes** and at **Rappaport Memorial**
- Umschlagplatz Gathering place before transfer to Treblinka Death Camp



- Visit the groundbreaking Museum of the History of Polish Jews (POLIN)
- Evening: Dinner, havdallah, and group night out in Warsaw's Old Town

SUNDAY | APRIL 27, 2025 | Treblinka

- This morning we travel north for a solemn visit to the stark **Treblinka Memorial** in the forest (lunch is provided en route)
- Return to the city for a visit to the Warsaw Jewish Cemetery one of the biggest Jewish cemeteries in the world – where we will be inspired by the life stories of Jewish leaders from preceding generations
- Visit the Jewish Historical Institute of Warsaw to view the "Oneg Shabbat" Archive a hidden testimony to the experience of Jews who lived and died in the Warsaw Ghetto
- Evening: Wrap-up session and celebrate the end of our journey over a closing dinner

- Celebrate the reunification of Jerusalem in 1967 recounting the story of Ammunition Hill
- Evening: Dinner on your own and join Jerusalem's *Erev Yom HaAtzmaut* celebrations!

THURSDAY | MAY 1, 2025 | Celebrating Independence

- Option #2 Free day to enjoy Jerusalem on your own
- Option #3 Celebrate Independence Day in Jerusalem taking part in March of the Living's parade from City Hall to the Western Wall
- Evening: Attend a special Yom HaAtzmaut concert and event sponsored by March of the Living International with dinner included

FRIDAY | MAY 2, 2025 | Returning to the Old City

- Break for personal exploration and shopping time in the Cardo area of the Jewish Quarter

- Return to our accommodations and prepare for our Shabbat in Jerusalem
- Kabbalat Shabbat options followed by a Shabbat dinner is at our accommodations, joined by Lone Soldiers in the IDF

- Break for lunch on own in Jaffa with time to explore the Jaffa Flea Market
- Discover the complexity and beauty of the graffiti art in Tel Aviv's Florentine neighborhood
 including the moving public art created to memorialize October 7th
- Celebrate the spirit of Tel Aviv at the Nahalat Binyamin Street Festival and Carmel Market
- Evening: Final shopping time, wrap-up session, and closing dinner at Sarona Market, the historic German Templar Colony transformed into a cultural center
- An optional airport transfer is included for those departing on overnight flights
